

Parish Council Minutes

Chair Update: Saint Rose of Lima also held an All Parish Meeting. It was well attended, had a positive atmosphere, and the feedback was that we should have these meetings more often. They are seeing the same trends affecting all Catholic parishes as well as small class size in the school and debt.

Team Updates: We need to get minutes posted and get them from each committee and team. Each committee needs to get their Highlights or Summaries to Maureen in the office so they can be passed on to the Parish Council. **Outcome:** Alisa to work with teams on this.

BAT Update: There are many ideas up in the air. When one decision is made, there will be a cascading effect on making all other decisions. The first question to answer is; what will it cost to move the staff over to the school location? Things to consider: flooring, wiring for computers, electrical needs, air conditioning, etc. **Outcome:** The Parish Council has voted to make the following recommendation to Fr. Paveglio. Obtain estimates for moving the office staff to the former school wing, while being open to options for renting either the PC or school wing. If the estimate meets with approval from the Finance Committee, then proceed to finding a renter for the Parish Center.

BAT is looking into the costs of three priorities, repair the leak in the roof, air conditioning, and parking lot repair or replacement. The BAT/PC needs to communicate and educate the parish on all decisions. Explain what the problem or the need for an improvement is before announcing what you have decided to do. This provides transparency and leads to better understanding of decisions. BAT/PC can work with CAT to expand communications.

CAT Update The front sign came up. Parish feedback is that an electrical sign is not a priority. Electricity to the sign lighting and street lighting has been lost. As a result the sign can only be seen during the day. **Outcome:** Candace to research possible sign solutions.

All Parish Meeting: There was enthusiastic participation during the meeting. Several commented that we should have these meetings more often. All of the comments have been compiled. **Outcome:** The staff will respond to any easy to answer concerns in the bulletin. The remainder of comments will be grouped in categories and presented to the Parish Council, if needed, for further review before presenting to parish.

Common Question: Many parishioners have been asking how they can best support Fr. Paveglio as he is the pastor of two parishes. We discussed possible answers to suggest. **Outcome:** Suggestions include: Volunteer more. Be open to change. Remember he is learning. You have the opportunity to be the teacher and should explain how you see things and what is important to you.

New Business: Consider for future meeting

1. We don't have a choir director. Do we need one?
2. Continue to acknowledge the grief from the loss of the 5:00 PM Mass and share parishioner comments/ideas.
